Being a caregiver for someone living with memory issues, such as dementia, can be a daunting challenge. That's why we created the AgingNext Memory Care Center. Whether you need someone to care for your loved one with memory impairment for an entire day or a half day, our memory care volunteers are here to help.

About the program:

The Memory Care Center serves as a safe, loving environment for older adults with memory impairment. All participants receive individualized and group attention, socialization and peer support. Caregivers can take a break knowing their loved ones are well taken care of.

Who is eligible?

Seniors aging at home who:

- Are living with dementia, including Alzheimer's disease
- Can no longer structure their own daily activities
- Are socially isolated and would benefit from companionship
- Cannot be safely left alone at home

How it works:

Our adult day program provides a safe, loving environment to meet the needs of older adults with memory impairment and their caregivers. Seniors receive individualized attention, socialization and peer support. The Memory Care Center is open Monday through Friday from 10 am to 4 pm. Caregivers can drop off their loved ones for a half day or full day. Either way, lunch is always provided!

Who benefits:

The Memory Care Center is great for participants and their caregivers. Participants receive attention and care while connecting with their peers. Caregivers get much needed time for themselves knowing their loved one is having a great time with friends and cared for by expert staff.

Daily activities include:

- Discussion groups on current events
- Mental stimulation games
- Daily exercises
- Gardening projects
- Arts and crafts
- Music
- Holiday and birthday celebrations
- Shared meals and snacks
- Pet visits
- Community outings (Extra fee may be required)
