STACY'S CRAFT KITCHEN



Materials

- 2 Colorful Socks
- 1 White Sock
- Rice: To fill body
- Fur: For Beard
- Polyfil/Cotton: To fill hat
- Other: String(dental floss), small rubber band, glue gun, decorations for top of hat, blush to color nose, ribbon or string to strengthen body shape.

Directions:

- Fill white sock with rice to desired size of gnome.
- Cut to size and tie off with rubber band or string to secure.
- Pinch rice to pull out nose: use rubber band to secure and tie off with string.
- Use blush to color nose.
- Cut off "body" sock at center of heel, pull up around white sock fitting under nose, and pull up a little higher in back. Glue onto white sock.
- Cut Beard/Fur to size your choice. Be sure to not cut the fur! Only cut backing so that the beard flows over edge.
- Cut a small V in the top center of beard to fit under nose.
- Glue on Beard.
- Cut off sock at heel for "hat", put a cotton ball or cotton in "toe" of sock and tie off to make a pompom. Fill with cotton and pull over head. Pull to cover white sock and keep adjacent to beard. Glue on (avoid gluing onto the beard)
- To keep your gnome standing tall, tie a ribbon or string around center of body.
